For the avoidance of doubt, this includes those who have retired and receive their pension on an annuity basis and those that receive survivorship pensions.

It is run by its members for its members and elects a Committee from amongst its members to co-ordinate the Association's activities and publish its newsletter. We aim to keep former colleagues in touch with each other.

NCI Pensioners' Association – Privacy Statement

This privacy statement sets out how the NCI Pensioners' Association ("the Association") uses and protects any information that you give us when you become a member of the Association. We are committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Given the information we request, we are not required to register with the Information Commissioners' Office, but we are still required to comply with the UK GDPR*.

The information we hold about you

Information is collected to help us administer the Association, and to inform you of present, past and future activities; we will also notify you of the life events of members where they, or their families, ask us to do so. For members of the Association, we collect your name(s), and contact information including postcode and email addresses, and other information relevant to the administration of your membership. We will only hold this information for as long as you are a member.

How we use this information

The Association uses this information to provide you with information which we believe will be of interest to you, including a copy of Contact Magazine. Your details will only be available to Committee members administering the Association and will be held secure. Under no circumstances will your personal details be shared with others without your permission.

Your rights

You have the following rights regarding your personal data:

- The right to be informed about any data we hold about you;
- The right to request a copy of your personal data which we hold about you;
- The right to withdraw your consent at any time (if applicable);
- The right to request that we correct any personal data if it is found to be inaccurate or out of date
- The right to request that your personal data is erased where it is no longer necessary for us to retain such data;
- The right, where there is a dispute in relation to the accuracy or processing of your personal data, to request that a restriction is placed on further processing;
- The right to object to the processing of your personal data (if applicable);
- The right to obtain and reuse your personal data to move, copy or transfer it from one IT system to another (if applicable).
